### Purpose

To give leadership to the reaching of every student within your assigned scope.

### Qualifications

- Commitment to utilize catalytic strategies to open all assigned campuses.

We believe that within 5 miles of every campus, God has already placed the resources to reach that campus for Christ. It might be a student, a volunteer, a faculty member, or a local church that can own the reaching of that campus.

### Responsibilities

- Complete Basic Campus Training under the direction of the Catalytic Director.
- Situational analysis of campuses within your assigned scope (5-20) campuses.
- Network to surface a qualified key leader for each campus.
- Initiate ministry on 8-10 campuses and prayerfully launch 5 campuses each year.
- Help each key leader establish a core team of 10 aligned students to launch the ministry on that campus.
- Help each campus establish the foundation of prayer it needs to move ahead.
- Involve the core team of students on each campus in Crusade events like Christmas Conference, Big Break, and summer projects.
- Provide for ongoing training and discipleship of students and volunteers in conjunction with your team.
- Help each student team to develop a campus movement that grows from 10 to 50 and beyond and that accomplishes the success criteria of the US Campus Ministry.
- Participate in the Leadership Development process of the US Campus Ministry.
- Attend the Catalytic Leadership School or receive comparable catalytic training.
- Attend the Catalytic Field Training or receive comparable catalytic training.
